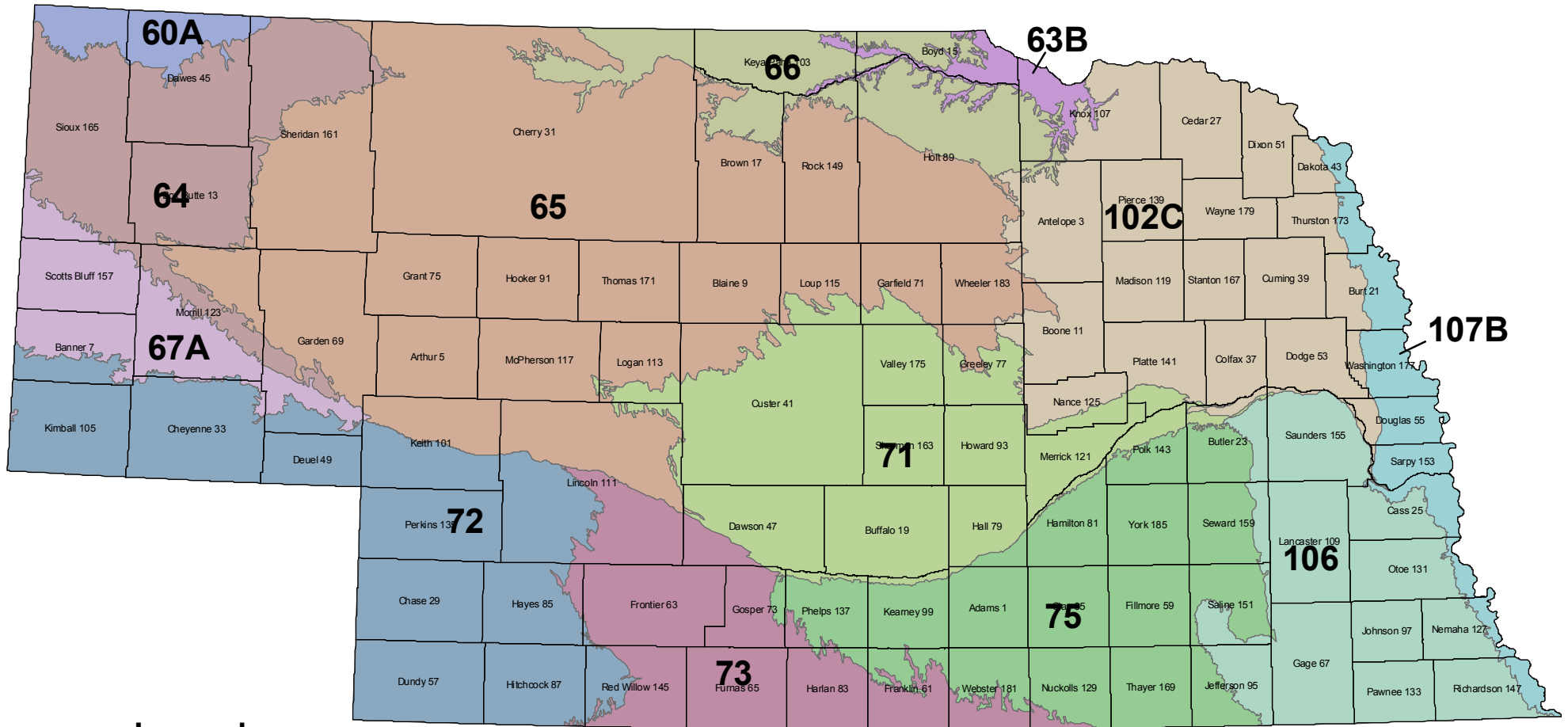


# Nebraska's Major Land Resource Areas
